



WHAT IS ESOS?

ESOS is the UK's response to Article 8 of the European Commission's Energy Efficiency Directive. The aim is to cut carbon emissions by requiring large businesses to identify energy reduction measures and make energy savings. Thousands of UK organisations are affected by the scheme. If your company is affected you're required to produce detailed reports on their energy use every four years. The qualification date and compliance date for each phase are provided below:

PHASE	QUALIFICATION DATE	FOUR YEAR COMPLIANCE	COMPLIANCE DATE
PHASE 1	31 December 2014	6 December 2011 - 5 December 2015	5 December 2015
PHASE 2	31 December 2018	6 December 2015 – 5 December 2019	5 December 2019
PHASE 3	31 December 2022	6 December 2019 – 5 December 2023	5 December 2023

ESOS will apply to your company if:

1. it has more than 250 employees, or
2. has an annual turnover exceeding €50m and a balance sheet exceeding €43m

For UK incorporate groups, if any part of the group qualifies for ESOS, then the whole group must comply.

The qualification date for the second phase is the 31st December 2018. That may sound like a long time away, but why wait? If you believe that your organisation will qualify for this next compliance period, you could plan your compliance strategy and implement a rolling programme of energy audits over the remaining period leading up to the deadline. By the next deadline your organisation will be well placed to comply with its ESOS obligations and financially benefit from implementing energy saving opportunities.
